We collect, use, and disclose personal health information for the following purposes:

- To provide pediatric therapy and family supports to our clients
- To comply with our regulatory obligations to our applicable colleges (College of Occupational Therapists of Ontario, College of Physiotherapists of Ontario, College of Audiologists and Speech-Language Pathologists of Ontario, Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers, and College of Psychologists and Behaviour Analysts of Ontario)
- To promote our organization, changes to our services, or advise clients of special opportunities (but we will always obtain express consent to do so)
- To conduct quality improvement and risk management activities
- To contribute to the education and development of future and current professionals
- To obtain payment for services provided
- To facilitate the sale of the organization in the event of a change of ownership
- For other purposes permitted by law

We will collect, use, and disclose only as much personal health information as is needed to achieve these purposes. You can withhold or withdraw your consent to the collection, use, or disclosure of your personal health information by contacting us (details below).
